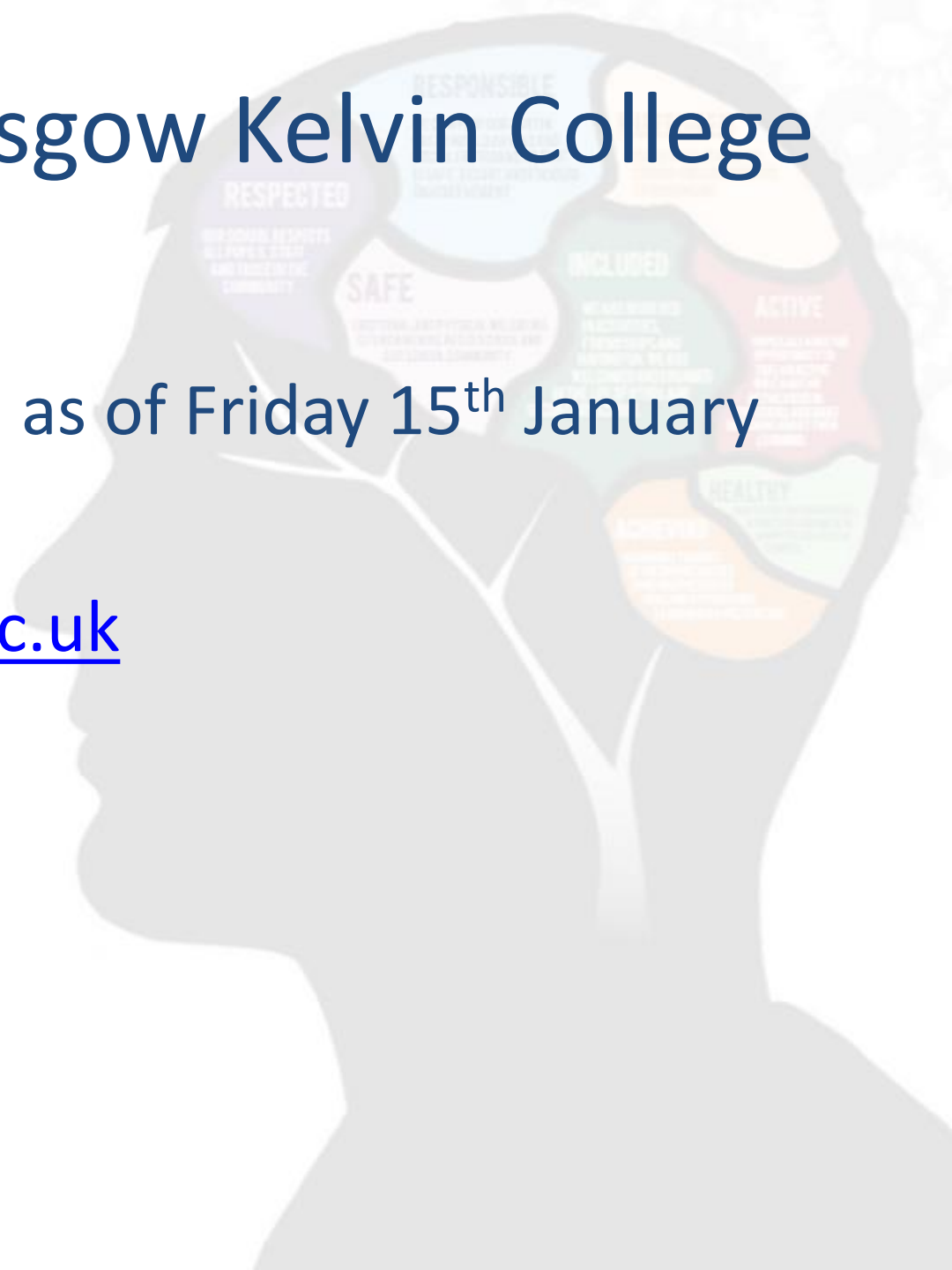

What do you need to do?

- Research courses – Vanessa can give you some help with this but it is important that you have an idea about what you want to study.
- If you don't have any idea please speak to Vanessa ASAP – she can advise you of websites and places to research to get some ideas.



What do you need to do?

- Once you have an idea of what you want to study – you should try to draft a personal statement – this is not a long document.
- There is lots of advice and guidance on the S5 / S6 year group team (files section) to help you with this – if you work through the template given it should be easy to do.
- You should then email her your first draft for checking.



Important things to remember:

- Colleges start to give out offers and places to applicants immediately – so you CANNOT afford to wait until mid February to apply!
- As part of the application process you are required to provide an email address – colleges will contact you directly on this so you must keep each day – we would suggest you use your glow email for this purpose.
