Playground tour

LE and JN led a tour focusing on the area west of Airlie Building, bordering Airlie Street. The lower part was this week marked out as a basketball court with possible other use of the adjacent disused undercroft and former janitor's house.

JN said she wanted to create a new PE area because of lack of space for multiple classes.

She showed an example of a shipping container-style unit for equipment storage and sports activities that opens lengthways, at Newbattle High School in Dalkeith. Possible cost £2-10,000

LE to meet school facilities management to discuss, and would also ask about use/possible removal of garage in main part of playground to create more space.

New mobile phone policy

LE said the new policy that phones must be put in school bags during classes had been broadly welcomed with positive feedback from pupils and teachers. However, some parents had heard examples of the policy not being implemented inconsistently, highlighting the need for continued efforts to ensure it was consistently enforced.

Awards ceremony

RF asked whether only those who achieved straight A grades should be celebrated at the event and suggested a discussion around what constituted success.
