Dear Parent or Guardian,

As you will be aware since starting in August 2019, all first year students have been required to stay in the school building or playground area during interval and lunchtime so that we can be sure our young people are safe and supervised by staff.

From January 2020 onwards arrangements will change slightly for our S1 students. At interval time all students in S1-S3 are required to stay within the school grounds and are able to purchase food from the Fuel Zone or from the Hyndland Hut which is located in the playground area – this arrangement will stay the same all session.

At lunchtime, which runs from 12.40pm until 1.30pm, S1 students will be granted permission to leave the school grounds however there will be restrictions on where the young people can go to during this time. The shops which are located on Clarence Drive outside of the main school entrance on Lauderdale Gardens or the School Football Pitch can be used during this time. Students in S1 are not permitted to go any further than this for the remainder of the session – this is to ensure that firstly our young people remain within the vicinity of the school community for safety reasons, but also to ensure all young people arrive at their period 5 class promptly for learning to begin after lunch.

If any S1 student does not remain within these designated areas it will result in their movements being restricted for a period of time i.e. will have to remain in the Fuel Zone supervised by staff, and parents will also be informed.

We hope that parents / carers can understand why these restrictions are in place and would very much appreciate parents reminding their young people of this information at home.

Finally, we are very proud of the reputation which our school holds within the community of Hyndland and we would remind our young people as they use the local shops and football pitch to help play their part in keeping our local environment tidy by disposing of any litter in a responsible way and also acting in a safe and responsible manner whilst showing respect to other members of our local community.

Payment can either be made at this stage or can be made up to Friday 30th August. Please put cash or a cheque in an envelope with the pupils name and class clearly marked.
