Dear S4 Families,

Following the recent formal diet of prelim assessments which our S4 learners have undertaken, teachers have recently given the third round of interim tracking grades for all pupils in Fourth Year. This working grade is intended to give a reflection on the **current evidence of progress.** We are really keen that the 4th year take this information to plan/inform their next stages as they prepare to complete their National Qualification courses and prepare for the SQA formal examination diet which is due to run in May/June 2022. The indication of effort, behaviour and homework should also provide a platform for discussion to ensure maximum effort is being applied consistently.

It is vitally important that all of our S4 continue to take and act on advice from staff re next stages. Strong attendance, timekeeping, application, homework returns and home routines continue to be vital in ensuring we are gaining robust evidence of progress and our S4 pupils are on course to achieve their full capabilities.

To help support our S4 learners, staff have again undertaken learner conversations in each subject area. During these learner conversations, students were given feedback on how they are progressing and what steps they can take to improve between now and the final tracking report which will be issued in April. We would encourage families to discuss these targets at home – students will have a record of their learner conversations on their school iPad and glow account.

We would like to remind both our S4 learners and their families of the wide range of support that continues to be on offer to support them as they prepare for their final SQA assessments in April/May. Below is a summary of the main supports available:

Supported Study - in school provision

A second block of supported study will commence in February. Learners will be provided with a timetable which will also be posted on the school website. We would strongly encourage our learners to make use of this fantastic support.

Saturday Study breakfast support

Our ever-popular Saturday Study support started back again on 5th February. This runs in the school library each Saturday from 9.30am until 12.00pm. The list of teachers attending each week will be posted on the year group teams in advance. Young people must sign up in advance using the glow form each week that is posted on their year group team.
