SPERO MELIORA - I HOPE FOR BETTER THINGS

Expectations of Schools

- Provide an estimate grade based on a holistic review of candidates performance.
- Base the estimate on 4 robust pieces of evidence gathered under exam conditions.
- Evidence must cover all aspects of the N5 Course.
- Evidence must be moderated across local schools

SPERO MELIORA - I HOPE FOR BETTER THINGS

Expectations of Schools

- Have the evidence available for SQA scrutiny.
- If the credibility of any evidence is in doubt, it cannot be used.
- Candidates should have access to the same assessment arrangements as they are entitled to in a formal SQA exam.

N5 Course Coverage

- SQA have now provided advice in all subject areas.
- Teachers will guide you as to the appropriate use of SQA Past Papers in your revision.
- In most subjects, the assignment has been removed – although NOT Computing & Admin.
- Estimate must have evidence of performance in all areas of the course.

SQA Verification Visits

- Teachers mark assessment.
- Departments must moderate and cross mark their own assessments.
- There will be cross moderation – we will be moderated by 3 other schools.
- SQA will visit our school and will examine assessment materials. They will look at the standard of the assessment and the standard of the candidate responses.

SPERO MELIORA - I HOPE FOR BETTER THINGS

Department Tracking & Algorithms

- We must provide SQA with departmental tracking data to evidence the consistency of candidates performance.
- Inconsistencies in performance will be subject to further scrutiny.
- Algorithms will NOT be used in determining candidates final grade.
- Algorithms may be used by the school to identify unusual trends in candidate tracking.

Collusion

- Collusion – working with others when you should be working on your own.
- Everyone involved is breaking the rules.
- Teachers are familiar with your work so will recognise any change in style or language
- Teachers know their subject so will recognise different sources.

Plagiarism

- Plagiarism – pretending that other people's work is your own.
- This is cheating!
- It is not your work if it has been produced or worked on by someone else.
- It is not your work if you copy from a book or website.

Exam conditions

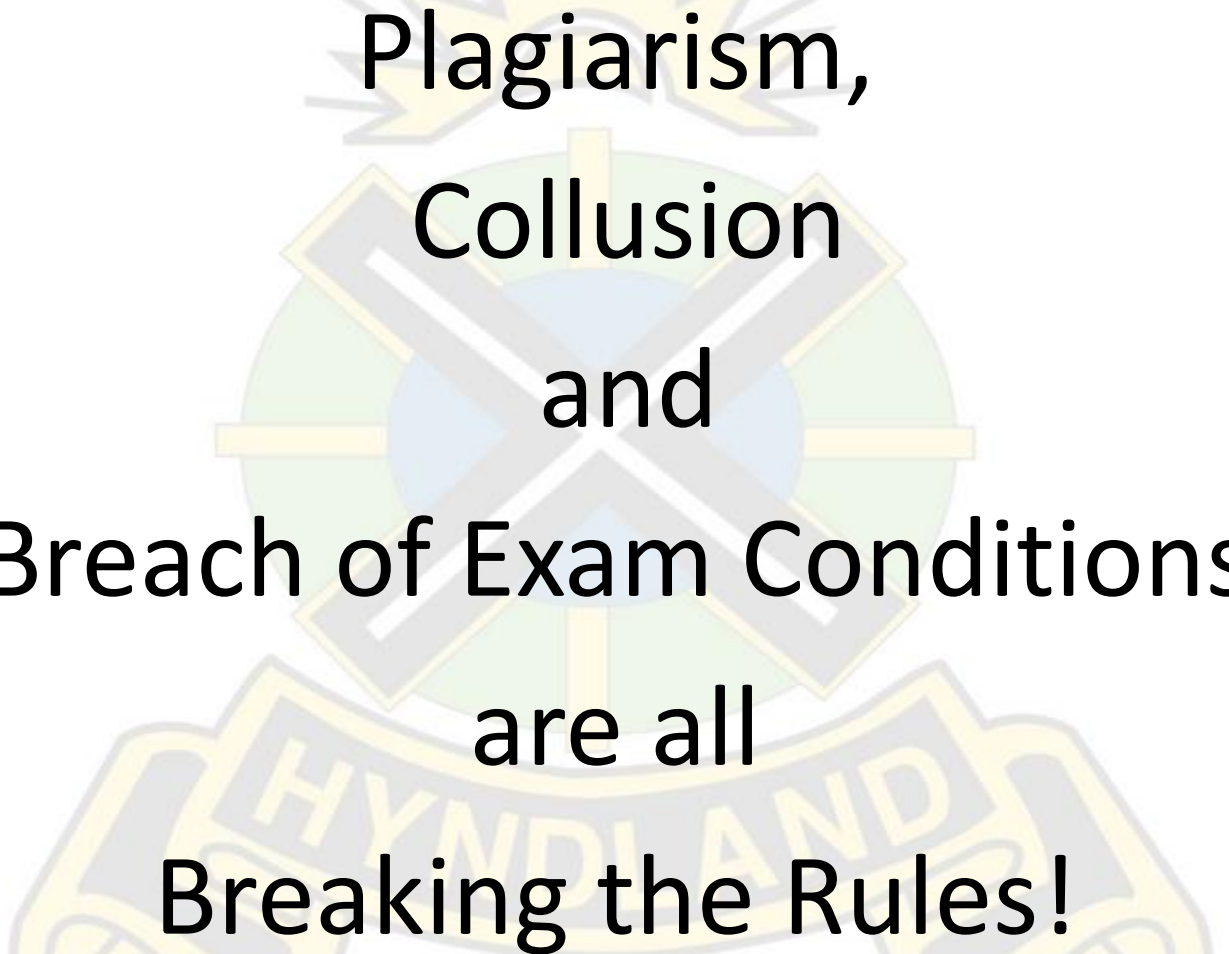
- You should not talk or communicate with any person in the room except the teacher.
- If you need to speak to the teacher, raise your hand and wait for the teacher to respond.
- You should be responding to 'unseen' questions and not have any knowledge of the paper in advance.
- Do not ask friends about the content of the assessment – especially those who have completed the assessment before you – this is Collusion.

SPERO MELIORA - I HOPE FOR BETTER THINGS

Exam conditions

- You must not access your phone, iPad, smart watch or other device with storage or internet access.
- The only items on your desk should be stationary associated with the assessment e.g. pen, pencil, question/answer paper, ruler, calculator etc.
- You have access to Alternative Assessment Arrangements, AAA such as extra time, access to ICT etc, This must have been agreed with Mrs J McFarlane, PT Support for Learning in advance of any assessment.

Exam Integrity

- Software is used to identify plagiarism, collusion and breach of exam conditions.
- Evidence is gathered under exam conditions.
- The integrity of each exam must be preserved so that candidates get due recognition.
- Before prelims, young people will be asked to sign a declaration to confirm that their SQA evidence is all their own work.

What if I break the rules!

- Any penalty imposed will depend on how serious the matter is.
- Your marks may be reduced.
- You may be awarded ZERO marks in a paper.
- Your qualification in that subject may be cancelled.
- ALL of your qualifications may be cancelled
