Expectations of Schools

- Schools provide the venue for the SQA Exams
- Schools have a team of invigilators who run the Exams
- Schools support the invigilation team in their duties

Exam Timing

- The exam timetable states the start and finish time of the Exam – Do not be late!
- The exam duration must be strictly adhered to
- There is no alteration or extension to the allotted time— if you are late, you will not get the time added on at the end
- If you are very late you will not be allowed in!

What to bring!

- Bring appropriate pens, pencils, rulers, calculator – sharing of calculators is not allowed
- Bring a small bottle of water so you do not need to visit the toilet
- Bring handkies

On the day of an exam

- Be in school at least 10 min before the scheduled start time
- Know your candidate number written on your SQA card
- Know your seat number these are displayed
- You must attend the exam unless there is a serious medical reason – you will need a medical certificate from your doctor.

Prohibited Items

- Mobile Phones these must be switched off and left in the centre designated area
- Digital electronic devices Earpods, iPods, tablets, smart watches
- Books, sketches or paper
- Notes except AH English, N5/H Dance
- Pencil case or calculator case
- English dictionaries

In the exam hall

"You should now undertake a final check to ensure that you do not have any prohibited items at your allocated seat. If you do, these must be handed over now. If you are found to have any prohibited items at your allocated seat once the exam has started, it will be considered a breach of regulation which will be reported to SQA and could have serious consequences for your award."

In the exam hall

- Use blue/black ink not gel pens
- Enter the details of your birth date not the date of the exam
- Rough working should be written in the answer booklet or on rough working paper provided – score through any rough work

During the Exam

 Under no circumstances may a question paper of any kind be removed from an exam room, either by a candidate or by any other person, before the agreed finishing time of the exam.

Late admission of Candidates

- Candidates arriving late may be admitted up to 30 minutes after the official start time.
- In the case of an assessment involving either a continuous playing of recordings or dictation, candidates arriving late will **not** be admitted.
- No extension of time can be granted to latecomers – no matter the reason for their latecoming. The end time of the exam is fixed.

General Instructions

- If the duration of the exam is less than one hour. Candidates MUST remain in the exam hall for the full duration of the exam.
- Candidates will not be re-admitted to the exam hall once they have left.
- Only candidates who have agreed assessment arrangements notified by Mrs McFarlane can access these during an exam.

Candidate Behaviour

Candidates must not:

- Take in notes
- Use scrap paper for working you must use SQA rough working paper
- Communicate in any way with, seek assistance from or give assistance to another candidate during an exam
- Intentionally cause a disturbance in the exam room
- Remove any exam materials from the exam hall.

Preparation

- Organise your equipment the night before an exam.
- Get a good nights sleep
- Set an alarm
- Make sure the people you live with know you have an exam so waken you
- Have a decent breakfast so you are not distracted by hunger
- Dress in layers so you do not get too hot/cold

Collusion

- Collusion working with others when you should be working on your own.
- Everyone involved is breaking the rules.
- Teachers are familiar with your work so will recognise any change in style or language
- Teachers know their subject so will recognise different sources.

Plagiarism

- Plagiarism pretending that other people's work is your own.
- This is cheating!
- It is not you work if it has been produced or worked on by someone else.
- It is not your work if you copy from a book or website.

Collusion and **Breach of Exam Conditions** are all **Breaking the Rules!**

Integrity

The practice of being honest and showing a consistent and uncompromising adherence to strong moral and ethical principles and values.

Exam Integrity – conditions must be the same for everyone – unseen questions, appropriate standard, accurately marked so results are FAIR

Exam Integrity

- Software is used to identify plagiarism, collusion and breach of exam conditions.
- Evidence is gathered under exam conditions.
- The integrity of each exam must be preserved so that candidates get due recognition.
- Young people have been asked to sign a declaration to confirm that their SQA evidence is all their own work.

What if I break the rules!

- Any penalty imposed will depend on how serious the matter is.
- Your marks may be reduced.
- You may be awarded ZERO marks in a paper.
- Your qualification in that subject may be cancelled.
- ALL of your qualifications may be cancelled
