What's Happening?

Every pupil in Hyndland Secondary will be getting an iPad

You'll also get a case and a charger for it!

You'll get access to the internet in school and apps that will help you in class!

Why is it happening?

Every pupil in Glasgow is being given access to an iPad

1 each from P6 onwards

1 between 5 from P1 to P5

It means everyone gets access to technology – not just those who can afford it!

Why is it happening?



What will be the benefit?

Everyone will have digital tech they can use in their lessons

Subjects that don't always get on the computers will be able to all the time!

This means you'll be able to do research, complete work, submit work online

All much easier than you do now!

What do you
need to do?

Bring it to school every day!

Make sure it's charged up
every day!

Keep it safe and look after it!

If it gets lost, stolen or
damaged – report it ASAP!!

What next?

There are iPad agreements being handed out!

This needs to be signed by you and your parent in order to get your iPad!

We're planning to hand them out in January! So we need to get all this paperwork sorted well before then!

What happens on the day?

There will be a timetable so you know where to go and when

A teacher will be in charge of giving out the iPads to a group of 20 pupils at a time

You will need to know your login and password for the computers **AND** for Glow

What happens on the day?

In order to get your iPad, you will need to know the following:

- Your username and password to get on the computer
- Your username and password to get onto Glow
- You will also need to set a new password for your Apple ID
- You will need to set a passcode

- ▶ Everything that you use on Glow – Word, Powerpoint, Excel etc
- ▶ Onedrive to save your files online!
- ▶ Apps like teams and showbie can be used to make “Digital Classrooms” where you can send/receive work and ask questions

- ▶ You'll be able to make presentations more personal by using the camera, green screen and more interactive!
