



Faculty of Social Subjects Production of SQA Provisional Results 2021

Introduction

This guide will inform the production of provisional grades as part of the Alternative Certification Model for session 2020-21. It will outline how staff have arrived at provisional grades this session and what evidence has been utilised to support this for Advanced Higher, Higher and National 5 levels.

Evidence Production

Evidence to support provisional results has been produced in a number of ways. Most of your evidence to support provisional grades has been produced post-Easter break in timed, supervised assessment conditions.

- In-class assessment in November Pre-Prelim (National 5 only) using assessment materials.
- Timetabled recovery assessment diet in April 2021.
- Timetable assessment diet in May 2021 using the amended secure SQA papers.
- For Advanced Higher History, your dissertation has also been included when producing your provisional result.

Evidence has been moderated and cross marked at both departmental and authority level.

Geography

For National 5 the student's best score in the two timed papers produced post-Easter break are noted with the November pre-Prelim counted where appropriate.

For Higher, the student's best score in the two timed papers produced **post-Easter break** are noted.

History

For Advanced Higher History the student's best score in the two timed papers produced post-Easter break are noted with the dissertation included.
