In School Supports

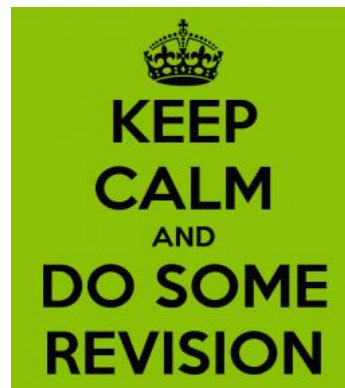
Saturday Study Breakfast Support

S4 - This runs each Saturday during the months of October and November. It will then commence again in February.

S5/S6 – This runs each Saturday during December and January.

Students can sign up via their year group team. They must sign up each week in advance.

A range of staff will attend each week to offer subject specific support, however it also provides learners with a quiet space to work either individually or in groups.



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Supported Study Programme

A programme of Supported Study will run in the school for two blocks.

Block one will run from Monday 1st November to Friday 10th December 2021.

Block two will run from Monday 31st January to Friday 25th March 2022.

The programme for block one has been posted on the year group teams and this is also found on the back page of this booklet.

Young people do not need to sign up in advance - they simply turn up each week.



School Website Study Materials and Support Videos

We have a dedicated section on our school website for supporting private study at home.

There is a useful booklet explaining different study strategies as well as a blank study timetable that can either be printed or downloaded at home to help young people plan their weekly revision schedule.

There are also a number of short videos created by our senior students which share their experiences of studying for SQA exams and offer useful hints and tips on the best ways to study for different subjects.

e-Sgoil Online Supported Study

Young people sign up using their Glow account and will be asked to provide their SQA candidate number.

Once they have signed up for this, they will be added to a Team and be invited to attend weekly sessions.
