We are very much looking forward to welcoming your child to Hyndland Secondary School in August as part of our new S1 intake, and we hope that your young person is looking forward to joining the Hyndland Secondary school community.

To help your child prepare for starting high school in August, we plan to run a further transition visit towards the end of the summer holidays. This visit will be open to all primary 7 students and will involve a tour of the school as well as some workshops delivered by Hyndland Secondary School staff.
